

Elisa Community terms and conditions

As a user of Elisa Community and OmaYhteisö (<http://yhteiso.elisa.fi>, "community" as stated later in this document), you expressly agree to these terms and conditions.

You agree not to engage in any unlawful conduct in the community. In particular, do not post, publish, or distribute any defamatory, obscene, infringing or other unlawful material or information in the Community. Do not contribute content that contains photos, software or other material protected by intellectual property laws, rights of privacy or publicity, or any other applicable law unless you own or have rights to these materials. Do not use the community to spam other users, including sending identical and irrelevant submissions to many different discussion groups, mailing lists or communities. You are solely responsible for the content of your computer and any transmissions you make when using the community. If you see any content that violates these terms and conditions, report that content immediately to moderators. Posts and comments on any part of the community may be edited, moved, deleted or removed at any time and for any reason and without notice by any Elisa employee or representative.

You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your password and account, and are fully responsible for all activities that occur under your password or account. Elisa cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to maintain the confidentiality of your password and account.

All messages a user publishes in the community are stored indefinitely. If a user wishes to have their profile erased, they should contact an admin. After the erasure their username will be replaced with a general username in all the messages that this user has sent (not in quoted messages).

IPaddresses are logged. Elisa reserves the right to suspend your account temporarily or permanently if you violate these terms and conditions. The suspension will be based on the IP- address and/or the personal information you provide while registering to the community. This community contains cookies, which are used to optimize the efficiency of the website for the user. A cookie is a small text file that contains your login information and is stored on your device when you visit the community. If you access the community via device that is in public use, be sure to delete cookies after you log out.
